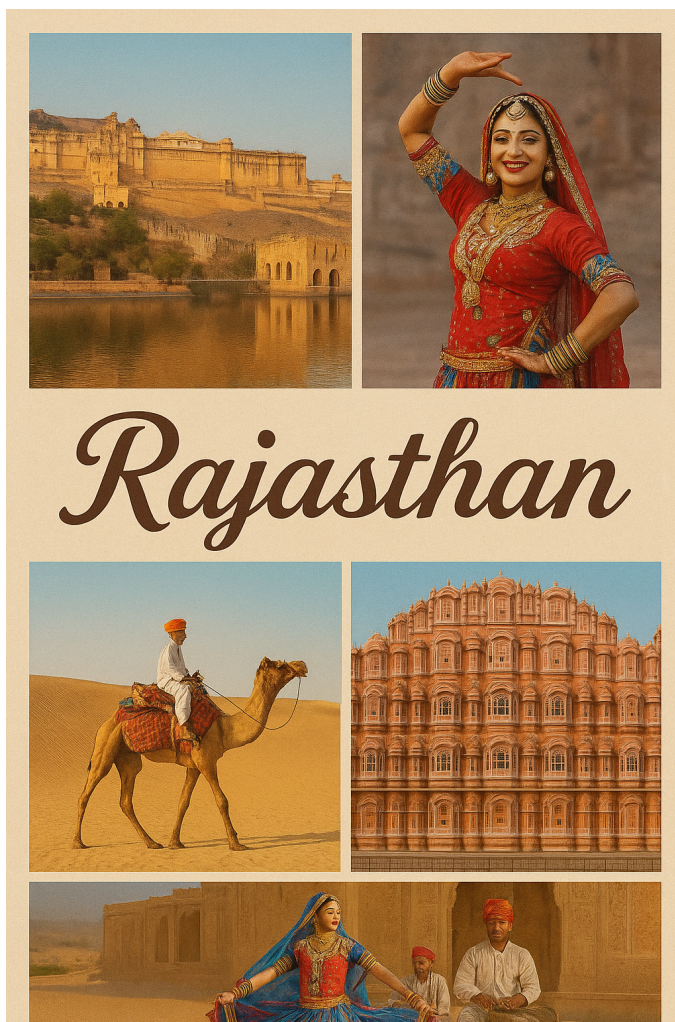

ITINERARY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN JAIPUR – THE PINK CITY WELCOME

Upon arrival in Jaipur, the vibrant capital of Rajasthan, you will be transferred to your hotel. After freshening up, embark on a half-day city tour visiting the majestic City Palace and exploring the colorful local markets bustling with handicrafts, jewelry, and traditional attire. Enjoy the charm of Rajasthan's royal heritage before resting overnight at your hotel.

DAY 02: JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING – ROYAL GRANDEUR AND HERITAGE

After breakfast, set out for a full-day sightseeing tour of Jaipur. Visit the magnificent Amer Fort, known for its artistic architecture and scenic hilltop views. Marvel at the Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds), explore the Jantar Mantar observatory, and revisit royal glory at the City Palace and Museum. End the day visiting Govind Dev Ji Temple and the serene Jal Mahal. Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 03: JAIPUR – SHEKHAWATI – BIKANER (350 KM / 6 HRS)

Drive to Bikaner after breakfast, visiting Shekhawati, famed for its beautifully frescoed havelis and traditional architecture in Fatehpur Shekhawati. Continue your journey to Bikaner and check into your hotel upon arrival. In the evening, visit the Camel Breeding Farm and the fascinating Karni Mata Temple (Rat Temple) at Deshnok. Overnight stay in Bikaner.

DAY 04: BIKANER – JAISALMER (370 KM / 6.5 HRS)

After breakfast, explore the impressive Junagarh Fort, an architectural gem built on the plains rather than a hill. Later, drive to Jaisalmer, the "Golden City" of Rajasthan. Known for its golden sandstone architecture and desert charm, Jaisalmer offers a glimpse into the grandeur of Rajasthan's past. Check into your hotel and relax for the evening.

DAY 05: JAISALMER – DESERT SAFARI EXPERIENCE

This morning, visit the majestic Jaisalmer Fort and the beautiful Havelis such as Patwon Ki Haveli and Nathmal Ki Haveli. See the serene Gadsisar Lake, once the main water source of the city, and the royal cenotaphs at Bada Bagh. In the evening, experience a memorable camel safari over the golden dunes of Sam Desert, followed by dinner under the stars at a desert camp. Overnight stay in Jaisalmer.

Highlights: Jaisalmer Fort, Havelis, Gadsisar Lake, Camel Safari, Desert Dinner

DAY 06: JAISALMER – JODHPUR (300 KM / 6 HRS)

After breakfast, visit the Jaisalmer War Museum, a tribute to the valor of Indian soldiers. Later, drive to Jodhpur, the "Blue City" of Rajasthan. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and relax for the evening. Overnight stay in Jodhpur.

DAY 07: JODHPUR – DEPARTURE

Enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour of Jodhpur after breakfast. Visit the grand Mehrangarh Fort, one of Rajasthan's best-preserved forts, offering panoramic views of the blue cityscape. Explore the elegant Jaswant Thada, often called the "Taj Mahal of Rajasthan," for its marble architecture and peaceful surroundings. Later, transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey.
